



Partnering India to Eliminate LF

For over two decades, GSK has been at the forefront of India's effort to eliminate Lymphatic Filariasis (LF), a debilitating disease affecting vulnerable populations, by supporting government efforts in partnership with the World Health Organization (WHO). In 2023, India advanced its commitment to eliminate LF by 2027, three years ahead of the global target. GSK remains committed to providing albendazole tablets until the disease is fully eliminated.

In FY 2024-25, we contributed 33 million tablets, bringing our cumulative contribution to an impressive 3.98 billion tablets—a testament to our unwavering dedication to public health.



Md Arbaaz A's story of perseverance and grit.

There was a period when all seemed uncertain. I came of age in Bidar, Karnataka, among a family of six. Our sole breadwinner was my father, a truck driver, until a stroke came out of nowhere and disabled him from working. My elder brother, early into his career, took on the responsibility. Life went topsy-turvy.

In spite of the hardships, my love for science increased further. I used to dream about being a doctor and struggled to get through NEET.

Entering one of the best medical colleges in Delhi was a huge achievement, but costs such as hostel charges, food, and study materials were soon piling up. My father even sold his truck to help us.

Next was the GSK Scholars Programme. Not only did it fund my studies, but it also allowed me to have peace of mind. I was then able to study without the constant pressure of financial troubles. Now in the last year of MBBS, I'm interested in cardiology and neurology. Someday, I hope to set up a clinic in some such place, back home, where competent care can transform lives.

I'm truly grateful to GlaxoSmithKline Pharmaceuticals Ltd. for making this journey possible.

Having grown up in a poor family in Imphal, Manipur, where my father and brother were drivers, financial difficulties almost foiled my ambition to become a doctor. Having failed MBBS by only three marks in my first attempt at NEET, I did not give up and passed it the second time. Due to my aunt's sacrifice and support of friends, I got admission into a government medical college.

The GSK Scholars Programme lifted a huge burden—covering my essential expenses and letting me focus entirely on my studies.

I'm now pursuing my MBBS, with a dream to specialize in cardiology and serve my hometown.

Chaitra S. Kurahatti, a third-year MBBS student at Belgaum Institute of Medical Sciences, is from Nargund in Karnataka's Gadag district. Her father is a physically handicapped farmer who cannot work and, hence, cannot pay for her studies. Though there were financial difficulties, Chaitra toiled hard to achieve her dream of becoming a doctor.

The weight of hostel and college fees was huge—usually funded by loans—until she discovered the FFE scholarship through a friend. The GSK Scholars Program in partnership with FFE has been a game-changer, relieving financial pressure and enabling her to concentrate on studies. Motivated by her mother's unshakeable encouragement, Chaitra hopes to become an empathetic doctor committed to changing lives.

The GSK Scholar's programme in Association with FFE has provided her with the chance to follow this dream without the ever-present threat of financial insecurity.

Transforming Community Health Through Partnership and System Integration

GSK Pharma, in partnership with **SNEHA**, is addressing maternal and child health challenges. Aligned with the National Urban Health Mission (NUHM), the initiative has significantly contributed to raising awareness, improving access to essential services, and fostering collaboration among key stakeholders to advance maternal and child health and nutrition outcomes.

Benefitting 1745 beneficiaries, the project has a multi-pronged approach to deal with malnutrition among children aged under 5 years, maternal health and nutrition, family planning, and domestic violence. As the programme enters its final phase, the goal is to establish a sustainable model for independent healthcare access.

The Saksham Anganwadi initiative, in alignment with the state Women and Child Development Ministry's vision, is enhancing service quality and benefiting more than 120,000 individuals.







Noorjahan's leadership in addresing malnourishment

At the center of Janta Nagar, Mumbai, a strong instance of change led by the community emerged through the tireless efforts of Noorjahan Idrisi, a veteran member of SNEHA's Community Action Group. Noorjahan has been working tirelessly to support local families for nine years—organizing them for health services, spotting high-risk cases, and making follow-ups.

One of them was Mahenoor, a child to Shahjahan, a mother of four from humble backgrounds. Born through C-section following complications during pregnancy, Mahenoor at first displayed normal growth signs. But by her seventh month, frequent sicknesses resulted in extensive weight loss and a Severe Acute Malnutrition (SAM) diagnosis.

With the help of joint efforts by SNEHA staff, ICDS Sevika, and Noorjahan, Mahenoor was provided with timely medical care, dietary advice, and home hygiene education. She was admitted to Nutrition Rehabilitation Center for Medical Nutrition Therapy. In spite of environmental factors like poor sanitation around her home, regular follow-ups and family counselling improved her condition.

By March 2025, Mahenoor had moved from SAM to the category of Moderate Acute Malnutrition (MAM). Her weight rose to 8.12 kg, and her height to 78.2 cm—clear signs of recovery.

This is a testimonial to the effects of long-term, grass-roots health interventions and the dedication of community volunteers such as Noorjahan in changing the lives of people.



GSK-BITAN's Save Lives initiative has been implementing targeted interventions, including awareness and sensitization workshops, nutrition and health camps, and support for medical center registration. These interventions have helped improve the health of mothers and children.







- Increased Healthcare Access: Out of a total of 79 pregnant women supported, 81.48% Pregnant women registered their pregnancy within 12 weeks at govt. health facility, around 71% completed all four ANC check-ups.
- Adolescent Empowerment: Two new adolescent groups have been formed & awareness sessions on menstrual hygiene, personal hygiene, nutrition, the right age at marriage, and consequences of early marriage were conducted.
- Stakeholder Collaboration: Constant coordination and liaison with various stakeholders, including
 officials from Rabindranagar Police Station, Ward Councillor, Bank Managers, ASHA workers,
 Medical Officer of UPHC-III, ANM, ICDS workers, hospital authorities, brickfield owners, and the
 Masjid Committee., have significantly improved the integrated approach of the SAVE LIVES
 Project.

Firoza Khatun Kolkata, West Bengal

Firoza's Story - Persistence and coordination lead to saving lives

Firoza Khatun, a young woman from Naya Basti, experienced tremendous difficulties early in life—married at age 16, she miscarried in 2021 and sadly gave birth to a stillborn child in 2023. Although there were initial attempts by BITAN and GSK to provide her with antenatal care, restrictive family circumstances and the absence of spousal support prevented her from receiving regular care.

But 2025 was a turning point. With increased intervention by BITAN and MAS members—through frequent monitoring, home visits, family counselling, and direct interaction with her husband—Firoza got the care and support she required. On 22nd March 2025, she gave birth to a healthy baby girl in a health facility safely.

Her narrative is evidence of the efficacy of grassroots, long-term maternal health programs in empowering women and promoting safe motherhood.



Murselima Khatun Kolkata, West Bengal

Murselima's Story: Overcoming Barriers to Ensure a Safe Birth

Residing in the Nayabasti slum of Maheshtala Municipality, Murselima Khatun encountered several obstacles during pregnancy—including resistance to taking medical treatment, an unplanned shift, and preterm issues. She was initially reluctant and oblivious to available help when she was detected by BITAN's field staff and MAS members under the Save Lives Project, funded by GSK.

With regular counselling, emergency referrals, and facilitated care, Murselima was successfully able to deliver. Her infant, born as light as 1.5 kg, needed critical care. With the support of BITAN, she took up Kangaroo Mother Care, followed exclusive breastfeeding, and went for regular monitoring sessions. Against the odds, her baby's weight rose to 3.5 kg—a reflection of the effectiveness of community-based health interventions, early intervention, and ongoing maternal and newborn care.

The path of Murselima celebrates the influence of trust, connection, and tireless activity in reshaping the health effects of vulnerable households from urban slums.

Where Care Feels Like Home: A Ray of Hope

Comprehensive Support for Young Cancer Fighters

GSK, in collaboration with **St. Jude India Childcare Centres**, is offering essential support to children undergoing cancer treatment and their families. This support includes accommodation, nutritious meals, emotional assistance, and access to education during treatment. Parents are involved through recreational and skill-building activities, building a close community where they can draw strength, share their experiences, and support each other.

Diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL), Jeet's has been a path not only of medical treatment, but of courage, learning, and an abiding passion for life.

Since his first day at the St. Jude India ChildCare Centre, Jeet has been different. His curious questions, contagious energy, and passion for learning soon made him a favorite among peers and staff. Whether in educational classes, group activities, or creative play, Jeet tackles each day with curiosity and awe.

Guided by his caring father and grandmother—his pillars of strength—Jeet learns wisdom from their stories and inspiration from their presence. Their unwavering support, along with the supportive atmosphere of the Centre, has enabled him to confront each challenge with tremendous courage.

Vimala Devi: A Dream to Heal, A Journey to Rise

At the heart of every great dream is a determined spirit and Vimala Devi's story is a shining example. Studying in 12th Grade at Government Higher Secondary School, Somarasampeetai, Vimala comes from a humble background. Her mother, a homemaker, manages the household on a monthly income of just ₹4,000. With her father absent and her only sister now married, Vimala and her mother share a bond strengthened by love, dreams, and resilience. In 2022, Vimala's life took a transformative turn when she joined Project Puthri, supported by GSK at her school. Through Puthri, Vimala received essential learning materials notebooks, workbooks, and a career book tools that helped fuel her academic journey. But more importantly, it was the career coaching sessions that inspired her to dream bigger and reach higher. She is a regular and enthusiastic participant in every mentoring session. One of her most profound transformations came during the Puthri Talent Search Event, where Vimala conquered her long-standing fear of public speaking stepping up and addressing an audience for the very first time.

Applying the study skills she learned from Puthri, Vimala secured an impressive 502 marks in her 12th-grade examinations a testimony to her commitment and growth. When asked about her future, Vimala's voice is filled with conviction: "I aspire to become a lawyer to stand up for justice, and to stand strong for my family." She also participated in the Career Choice Assessment (PCCA) program, further solidifying her career aspirations. Her ultimate goal is not just personal success it's to support her mother financially and uplift the woman who has been her guiding light.

Today, Vimala Devi is more than a student from Government Higher Secondary School, Somarasampeetai. She is a beacon of hope and inspiration proof that with the right guidance and opportunities, dreams can indeed take flight.

Singham Grade VII, Noida, Uttar Pradesh

Story of Singham, a student of class 7A

His household was under severe stress caused by his father's alcoholism, coupled with financial problems and constant instances of domestic abuse. It was a challenging situation for the mother and the children.

Singham told us to support the family by facilitating sending his father to a

rehab center. He had hoped that, besides his drug problem, his father was an essentially good human being. The teachers at Vidya & Child met with his older brother, aunt, and mother, attempting to encourage and persuade them, as the situation was taking a very negative toll on the children. After many discussions and much contemplation, the family consented, and arrangements were made for his father to be admitted to a rehabilitation centre to start his road to recovery.

Meanwhile, the staff also motivated the mother to find employment to care for herself and her children. She later found employment as a housekeeping staff in a school. The father was back home after four months of care and rehabilitation and has since been fine. He is working as a tailor and picks up overtime to cater for the family. He now realizes his roles and has discovered how to eliminate his addiction.



Where Dreams Take Root: Transforming Lives Through Learning and Growth

GSK, in partnership with **Nai Dharti**, is working towards empowering underprivileged and deprived girls by offering them free residential formal school education, co-curricular activities, and vocational training.

GSK in partnership with Nai Dharti is supporting their Sister Nivedita Valika Vidyalaya, imparting free school education and developmental activities training for underprivileged girls. Since 2015, this initiative has empowered more than 1,000 underprivileged girls by providing safe accommodation, quality education, healthcare and vocational training.

In the past year alone, 116 residential students and 85 day scholars have benefited from the programme.



Programme Highlights

- Awareness and Check up camp for Menstrual Hygiene was organized in the school premises on August.
- HPV vaccination camp was organized in the School Campus on 15th August, where 10 girls, aged 14 years, were administered first dose of vaccine.


